



○ Red circle indicates CRITICAL MATCHPOINT or thread to thread matching
 Baste 6 stitches over red circle, check, rebaste if necessary. Stitch entire seam.

IN A NUTSHELL

- You will stitch on the printed side of the vellum.
- Your project develops face down on the paper – when you turn the paper over, you will see the RIGHT side of your project.
- Patterns will be cut apart, on the dotted lines, one section at a time, and assembled as you go.
 DO NOT WAIT UNTIL ALL THE SECTIONS ARE COMPLETE, TO ASSEMBLE.
- Always pin #1 to the pattern, right side down!!
- All other fabrics (except #1) will be placed on your sewing surface RIGHT SIDE UP!! Then place pattern on top.
- Within the section, fabric is added in numerical order
- ALWAYS, BUT ALWAYS, add 1/4" seam allowance to each section as you are trimming
- Sections are stitched together in alphabetical order
- Stitch adjacent to the paper, (not on) the paper when joining sections.
- Most errors can be avoided by being VERY generous with the size of the fabric you add.
- All paper will eventually be removed. Paper under the pressed seam allowance should be removed before pressing.
